

WORLD TREFOIL

ACTIVITY

Use the design below to make the pieces for the game.
For continued use laminate each of the pieces.

Cut a 6 ½ inch circle of blue color, similar to the real color of the pin
(If the design is enlarged, adjust the size of the blue so that the
gold open circle just fits over it)

Cut each of the parts of the World Trefoil out of gold

- ❖ compass needle
- ❖ two stars – laminate separately
- ❖ 3 leaves (6 parts) of trefoil – laminate this as one piece. Use
pattern below for placement for lamination
- ❖ flame
- ❖ open circle (lower part of the base extending around the trefoil)

The object of the game is to assemble the World Trefoil and learn the
meaning for each of the parts.

WORLD TREFOIL

After a roll of the dice, tell what each part means according to the number rolled

- 1 **COMPASS NEEDLE**
- 2 **STARS**
- 3 **TREFOIL**
- 4 **FLAME**
- 5 **GOLD OPEN CIRCLE**
- 6 **BLUE BACKGROUND**

Assemble the symbol by building it from 6 to 1
That is starting with the blue background (6), then the gold open circle (5), then the flame (4) etc.

Try to assemble the World Trefoil before three of the same number are rolled.

ANSWERS

- 1 **COMPASS NEEDLE** – points the way. It gives us direction. And keeps us on the right course.
- 2 **STARS** – There are two. One for the Promise and one for the Law
- 3 **TREFOIL** – This is a three-leaf symbol. Each leaf represents one part of the Promise
- 4 **FLAME** -- toward the bottom of the trefoil represents the flame of the love of humanity
- 5 **GOLDEN OPEN CIRCLE**– Represents the sun shining over all the children of the world
- 6 **BLUE BACKGROUND**– Represents the bright blue sky above all the world

Notice that the circle is not closed. That means that this world-wide organization is open to all.
